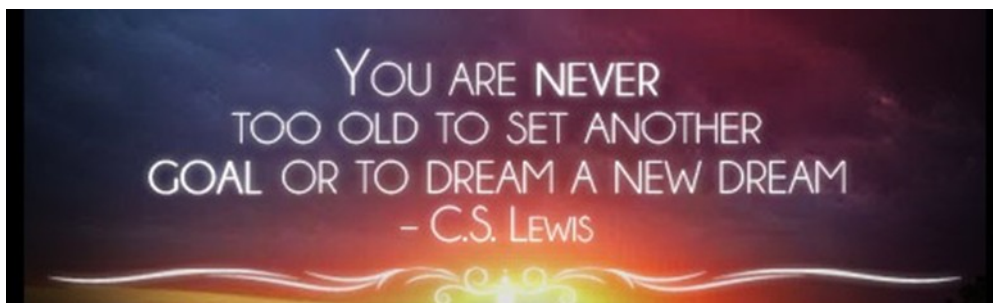
### DUKE TIP ASSET TALENT SEARCH
